Frequently Asked Questions

- Q. What if I can't find the pricing for a particular health care service or procedure?
- A. Please call the FMDH Price-Line at (406) 228-3511.
- Q. Why do you only include an estimate rather that the exact price?
- A. Actual charges vary depending upon many factors including, but not limited to:
 - a) your physician's treatment choices
 - b) actual services rendered
 - c) the severity of the problem
 - d) complexity of the procedure
 - e) how long the procedure takes
 - f) length of the hospital stay
 - g) post-operative course
- Q. If I have a surgical procedure done, are all of the costs included in the estimate?
- A. Yes, the estimate will include your hospital charges as well as the performing provider, anesthesiologist, etc.
- Q. Will my insurance affect the estimate?

A. Yes, if you have insurance coverage, your insurance policy (including deductibles, network coverage, copays, coinsurance, and out-of-pocket maximums) will help determine the amount you owe. For an estimate based on your insurance policy call the FMDH Price-Line at (406) 228-3511.
